**Don Voigt, M.S., P.E. of Energenecs Inc., Cedarburg, Wisconsin  
Bestowed National Water Industry Award**

Cedarburg, WI, January 29, 2007 – The American Water Works Association, the world's leading authority on potable/drinking water supplies for municipal water utilities, awards the Kenneth J. Miller Founders' Award annually, to the member who best exemplifies the tireless contributions of Kenneth Miller (a water supply consulting engineer from CH2M Hill of Denver, Colorado) to founding and evolving "Water for People" – a charitable organization committed to assisting developing nations' clean water supplies. The Wisconsin section of Water for People began by developing a water supply for a mission located in Guatemala and subsequently supplying safe water to over 5,000 people in the northern mountainous region of Guatemala. The original mission was affiliated with Sister Joannes Klas, a Catholic Missionary Sister from the Fredonia, Wisconsin area.
