

Sheboygan Water Utility  
Operations Supervisor

The Utility anticipates a salaried opening in its supervisory staff involving management of a 34 MGD conventional surface water treatment plant, 4 remote booster stations, and 5 water storage tanks under the direction of the Utility Superintendent. The position will directly supervise a staff of 2 foremen, 5 treatment operators, 1 maintenance / relief operator, and 1 lab technician, who are involved in the plant operation and other work duties. The position also involves significant contact with the public in dealing with water quality issues and providing educational outreach.

The ideal professional candidate must possess skills and substantial knowledge of, but not restricted to, the following areas:

- Water treatment fundamentals specific to a surface water plant
- Operation/maintenance of water treatment equipment
- Pump – motor operation/maintenance
- State and federal regulatory requirements
- SCADA systems
- Water distribution systems
- Water treatment laboratory procedures
- Optimization of chemical feed systems
- Microsoft office/spreadsheets/budget preparation
- Supervision/safety/training

Candidate must have excellent verbal and written communication skills, including the ability to utilize and explain operational data. An ideal candidate would have a four-year college degree in civil, electrical, mechanical engineering, or water sciences along with five years of experience with surface water plant operation. Additional experience would be considered in lieu of a specific four-year degree. A strong background in electronics, electricity, SCADA systems, and mechanics would be a plus, along with supervisory training or experience. Candidate must have a strong dedication to safety in the workplace.

The position will require a surface water operator certification from the WDNR within six months. The operations supervisor shares in distribution standby duty along with responding to all emergency problems at the water treatment plant.
